Payment Guidelines:

 The award will be paid upon the Scholarship Chair's receipt of documentation of the recipient's enrollment as a full-time student in any accredited two* or four-year college or university within the United States. The recipient must be a full-time student (12 credit hours/units minimum).

The deadline for submission of documentation for the first semester is October 15th each year, and the recipient must include his/her Student Identification Number.

The award will be paid directly to the recipient's institution in his/her name and can only be used for tuition, institutional fees, or books. Under no circumstances may the money go directly to the recipient. The Stockton Rotary Club will request sufficient documentation from the educational institution to ensure that the funds have been appropriately used.

It is the recipient's responsibility to see that he/she has submitted proper documentation, including his/her Student Identification Number, to the Scholarship Chair of the Rotary Club of Stockton in a timely manner. If the award is not given out due to a lack of documentation submission in a timely manner, the Rotary Club of Stockton reserves the right to award another student. Documentation must be submitted **NO LATER THAN October 15**th each year.

*In the event that the student attends a two-year community college, the award is for the cost of books, fees, and tuition up to the awarded amount and not the singular dollar amount as the community college charges may be less than the award.
